

## GUIDELINES FOR APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR OF VISITORS AT CULTURAL AND HISTORICAL SITES

Dear visitors of the Pomurje Museum Murska Sobota, please observe the following rules during your visit:

- 1. **Respect for Exhibited Objects**: Do not touch the displayed exhibits unless specifically permitted. This helps preserve them for future generations.
- 2. **Calm Behavior**: Move slowly and quietly through the museum. Avoid running, shouting, or engaging in actions that might disturb other visitors or damage the exhibits.
- 3. **Respect for Other Visitors**: Be considerate of other visitors. Do not obstruct their view of the exhibits and avoid loud conversations.
- 4. **Cooperation with Staff**: Follow the instructions of the museum staff. If you have any questions or need assistance, approach them. In case of an emergency (evacuation, fire, accident), follow their instructions.
- 5. **Photography and Filming**: Check whether photography or filming is allowed before taking any pictures. The use of flash or tripods may be restricted to protect the exhibits.
- 6. **Food and Drinks**: Eating and drinking are not permitted in the exhibition areas.
- 7. **Mobile Phones**: Set your phones to silent mode. Make phone calls outside of the exhibition spaces so as not to disturb other visitors.
- 8. **Personal Belongings**: Leave large bags, backpacks, coats, and umbrellas in the cloakroom or designated areas to prevent potential damage to the exhibits.
- 9. **Children in the Museum**: Children are welcome in the museum. Please supervise them and ensure they follow the behaviour rules.
- 10. **Accessibility**: If you have special needs or require assistance with access, please inform the museum staff, who will be happy to assist you.

Adhering to these guidelines will ensure an enjoyable experience for all visitors and contribute to the preservation of cultural heritage.
